

TOWN OF MARCELLUS
TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
July 25, 2012

A special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Marcellus, County of Onondaga, State of New York was held on at 7:00 P.M. in the Marcellus Fire Hall, 4242 Slate Hill Road, Marcellus, New York. Those present were:

Also present: Karen R. Pollard, Town Clerk, David Card, Marcellus Fire Department and approximately twenty-five residents.

Supervisor Ross opened the meeting at 7 P.M. with the reading of the legal calling for a Public Hearing on a mandatory referendum on the establishment of a fire service award program. The referendum vote will be held on August 21st from noon to 9pm at the Marcellus Fire Hall. Mr. Ross informed the meeting that the legal was published in the July 11th edition of the Marcellus Observer.

Mr. Ross turned the meeting over to Mr. Card who gave an overview of the program.

Supervisor Ross asked for anyone who wished to ask questions to please state his or her name and address for the record.

Peg Kronen, 2589 Otisco Valley Road, asked a number of questions on the running of the program, i.e.: who would administer the program, what about beneficiaries, who would qualify for the program. Mr. Card answered all of Ms. Kronen's questions.

Veronica Hughes, 3845 Slate Hill Road, questioned the lack of advertisement and information on this issue. Mr. Card explained that there is information on the fire department's web site and that there are plans for articles to be run in the Marcellus Observer.

Peg McNally, 5 Reed Street, asked what other fire departments the area had an awards program. Mr. Card stated that all but two departments in Onondaga County have an awards program.

With no more questions, the public hearing was closed by Supervisor Ross at 7:34pm.
