Attached are two draft copies of the invitation to bid packages for the Welcome Center project. We will also drop a copy off at Jim Gascon's office. The package should be considered draft until you consider the following items that we would like to bring to your attention.

#### 1. Invitation to Bid package:

- A State Department of Labor (DOL) project number and prevailing wage rate schedule needs
  to be assigned to the project. As indicated previously, in the past someone from the Town has
  requested this information. Once we receive the Prevailing Wage Case (PRC) number, we will
  add it to the package.
- We have a suggested schedule, but left the specific dates blank for you to consider:

- Painting / light updates
- Improve downspout discharge points with replacement gutters and downspouts.
- Installation of a board behind electrical meter/conduits for improved aesthetics and organization?
- Pre-Bid Meeting: The pre-bid site meeting will be the time to re-visit these issues.

#### 3. Town - Contractor Agreement:

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- A draft copy of the contract is included in the Invitation to Bid package. The terms of the proposed agreement should be reviewed carefully through legal counsel.
- The Town should consider the need for bonding requirements. There is a bid bond (at 5%) in the invitation to bid, and performance and payment bonds within the draft agreement between the Owner (the Town) and the Contractors.
- Liquidated Damages: Provides for contractor penalty payments should certain contract provisions become an issue.

Note that we understand the push to get this project completed, but for this anticipated scope of work, we would expect construction to not exceed four (4) weeks. Following your review, we can provide a quick update for bid distribution purposes and will deliver them to your office.

 Verify proposed schedule against the grant deadline and any corresponding invoice date requirements.

#### 2. Scope of Work:


- Roof. The existing roof is about 8 years old. Some Town representatives are recommending that it be replaced, and others feel it has another 10-12 years of useful life remaining. The bid package will reflect a unit cost for the complete replacement of the roof system based on an estimated square footage, but the Town will need to decide if it is a go or not.
- Siding: The limits of the siding replacement program need to be consistent for bidding. Similar to the roof limits, we have included an estimated quantity for bidding, but the Town needs to decide final areas of improvements.
- Color Scheme: The proposals reviewed from the contractors have different colors for roofing, siding and trim. The Town needs to specify their preferences, accordingly.
- Product Warranties: Roof and siding system warranties can vary. Roofs are typically between 25 and 40 years subject to the product selected. Siding appears to have 10 to 15year coverages.
- Gutter System: The Town should decide if fascia (face) mounted, or strap mounted gutters are preferred. We have specified fascia mounted.

#### Miscellaneous Items:

- Field measurements are to be conducted by contractor prior to ordering materials.
- Soffit and fascia replacement details ventilation / aluminum wrap, etc.
- Siding bottom considerations. Elevation of trim/siding to prevent damage from yard maintenance?
- Panel board considerations for wall-mounted utility services.
- Any changes to existing signs? Positioning and mounting? Review siding block provisions for hose bibs, etc.
- Voids in foundation are assumed to be handled by the Town.

Requirements to become a pick-up site.

Must have an approved POC.

Must have an approved site.

Trucks must be willing to deliver.

Site requirements- depends on the average monthly need for this area.

Utilized once a month for approximately 4 hours.

Trucks drop off 1 day a month. People must pick up their packages usually within a 2-2.5 hour period.
