Hi!

I was wondering if there was an official permitting process in order to sample Marcellus County Park for my SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry honor's research project. I was told by the DEC that it is not under their jurisdiction and to reach out to you. I've already talked to park caretakers and was told that it wasn't an issue and that I was allowed to conduct my research at the park, but I just wanted to make sure I have official documentation rather than a handshake agreement.

The project focuses on sampling crayfish (specifically *Cambarus robustus*) to catalogue the diversity of crayfish ectosymbiotic parasites (Branchiobdellida). I would be taking water quality data such as pH, temperature, DO, suspended sediment, and electrical conductivity from the 0m and 200m points from along a 200m transect line. I would also be counting the number of crayfish worms on each crayfish and collecting the worms for genetic analysis/identification.

I would be sampling Marcellus County Park for 5 days between ~ August 18th 2025 - August 22nd 2025.

OCWA would like to remind you that your backflow device, located at 24 E MAIN ST, is coming due for a required annual test within the next 30 days. Please hire a certified tester to perform your annual test on your device.

All backflow test results must be submitted, by your tester, using the VEPO CrossConnex software. Tests can also be submitted by your chosen tester at <https://www.vepocc.com> via a computer. Please provide your tester with your VCC# which is OCWA258708/1.

If your test is not completed in the next 30 days, you could be subject to a fine or disconnection of your water service. If your backflow tester has any technical questions regarding the software used to submit your test, please have them contact VEPO CrossConnex at 1-877-860-2776
