Along the Erie Canal

June 5th, 2024. Depart at 8:00am return at 7:45pm.

Upon arrival, we will enjoy a lunch buffet at Canalside in Lockport, NY. Canalside's history as an 1840's warehouse makes for a truly unique dining atmosphere. After lunch we will depart on a 2-hour Erie Canal cruise which includes "locking through" the Niagara Escarpment. While traveling along the Erie Canal, your captain will be leading the tour and sharing many interesting facts. We will finish this fun day with a stop at Becker Farms for pie, coffee, and a wagon ride.

Corning Museum of Glass

Upon arrival at the Corning Museum of Glass we will meet our greeter from the museum, and get checked-in, explain the museum tour map, live demonstration schedule, answer any questions you have and go over the pumpkin glass making schedule for the day. Pumpkin Glassblowing: A seasonal favorite, this experience allows you to work with hot glass up close while always staying on the cool end of the glassblowing iron. You will partner with our professional glass blowers to create your design, using a foot pedal to add compressed air into the blowpipe and watch as the pumpkin inflates and the glassblower guides and shapes the glass with special tools. A \$20.00 lunch voucher is included for lunch at the museum café. Following lunch. enjoy more free time at the museum, watch a live demonstration, and visit the gift shop. Afterwards, we will depart for Sauder's where we will enjoy free time for shopping, a break and if needed a snack before heading home.
