Registration Policies and Guidelines:

Please read the descriptions of each camp/activity carefully as the information varies.

Programming is based on the grade a child is entering in the 2024-25 school year.

- 1) An individual is not registered for a program or activity until all necessary forms are completed and returned to the Recreation Department with the correct payment. To avoid disappointment, please read all age requirements, immunization forms and registration fees.
- 2) All activities listed in this brochure have a minimum and maximum requirement for participation. While we make every effort to run all our programs as advertised, we reserve the right to cancel a program due to lack of registration. We will create waiting lists if maximum numbers are reached.
- 3) Please pay special attention to the beginning and end times of all activities. You CANNOT drop children off early or pick children up late. If you do, you will be charged an extra fee. There is no supervision outside designated times. Please be respectful of our staff.
- 4) Disruptive and unsafe behavior will not be tolerated at any of our camps or programs. Disruptive and unsafe behavior is anything that, in the opinion of the Parks & Recreation Director or camp supervisors, compromises the safety of others or quality of instruction. Individual situations will be assessed, and it will be up to the discretion of the Director whether a participant will be allowed to return to the program.
- 5) Activities with the Marcellus Recreation Department are NOT pro-rated.
- 6) Once you have registered yourself or your child for an activity, we do not make follow-up calls. You will only hear from our office if there is a change to the program.

It is the policy of the Marcellus Recreation Department that no child will be denied participation in the Children's Recreation Morning Program because of an inability to pay.

IF THE RECREATION OFFICE CANCELS A CAMP, ACTIVITY, OR TRIP:

We will refund all money if we must cancel any of our programs.

You may be required to sign a voucher to be submitted to the Town to receive the refund.

Please allow at least thirty days to process the voucher and return your money.

If you pay with a credit/debit card through Community Pass you will be issued a credit card refund.

IF YOU (OR YOUR CHILD) WITHDRAW FROM A CAMP, ACTIVITY OR TRIP:

If you cancel your registration BEFORE a program starts, you will receive a refund minus a \$25.00 fee. However, if you withdraw from a program after it has started, you will not receive a refund unless we cancel the program, someone on a waiting list can fill your vacant spot, or your request is accompanied by a doctor's written excuse.

Morning Playground Program

Children are divided into supervised groups according to the grade they are entering for the 2024-25 school year. All groups will have the opportunity to play outside games, play in the gym and participate in arts & crafts activities. Make sure your child dresses in comfortable clothing, sneakers, and sunscreen every day.

Please Note: If your child is signed up for afternoon camps (on the MCS campus) or field trips they are welcome to bring a bag lunch and eat in the cafeteria, where there will be supervision.

An Immunization record must be provided at time of registration.

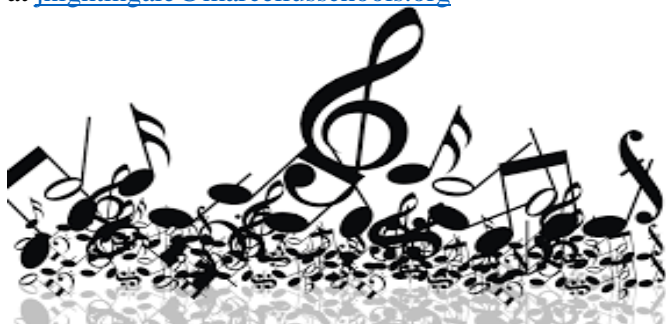
