Youth Summer Field Trips

The following packet contains all registration information for field trips with the *Marcellus Recreation Department* during the month of **July 2025**. We hope that this will eliminate any confusion during the hectic mornings at the Playground Program.

Online registration for youth field trips will be available online the week prior, closing on Sunday evenings. In-person registration will begin each Monday at 9:00am at DMS and will remain open until trip capacity has been reached. All field trips are on a first come, first serve basis until the trip is full. Each trip has its own limit as to how many students can participate. There are no waiting lists for full trips and **NO refunds will be given**. In-person payment is cash or check only.

Age criteria for field trips are based on the grade your child is *entering* during the 2025-2026 school year. Please note that your child(ren) may not be able to attend every field trip. All trips will leave and return to Driver Middle School (under the clock). All return times are approximate. All students attending field trips should bring a bag lunch. *For Jordan Pool, please have your child wear their swimsuit to camp to save time changing.* Please DO NOT allow students to bring valuable possessions (ie. cell phones and other collectibles) to activities. The Town is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Any student planning to attend any field trips in July must have the following form completed. This form only needs to be filled out once. Completing this form allows you to register your child for field trips.
