- The name of the business will be painted on the existing sign where AEI is
- Hours are Friday, Saturday, and Sunday from 10AM 5PM with extended hours on holidays. The store will be open from February till mid December.
- They currently have 7 parking spaces and 1 handicapped space.
- They can have no parking on the driveway
- The existing overhead door is not being used but they may use it
- They are leasing the building
- They have 2 vans and a truck to bring items on site deliveries will be done at different times at different times.
- Their business currently generates approximately 3 bags a trash a week and they don't anticipate more than that they will have no outdoor dumpster
- No plans to change the existing outdoor lighting they were advised if they change the lights it must be down lighting.
- There was discussion on how to expand the parking if necessary
- The PB had no issues with the project other than the possible necessity of additional parking and ingress/egress onto Route 20.

The applicant will complete a site plan application will submit additional information for the July meeting.
