The Planning Board of the Town of Marcellus met in regular session in the Marcellus Town Hall for the Town of Marcellus, located at 22 East Main St. Marcellus, New York, on March 6, 2023

<u>DISCUSION –</u>

<u>Lewis Loudermilk, 4663 Limeledge Rd – 1 lot subdivision</u>

A public hearing was held for a one (1) lot subdivision and special permit for a 36' X 56' accessory building. The secretary, Karen Cotter, read the legal notices into the minutes. Guy Donahoe, Architect, was present to represent the project. He advised that the applicant would like to construct a 36' X 56' accessory building to replace a smaller building that fell down during a storm. Mr. Donahue advised he had notified the neighboring property owner's daughter to discuss the subdivision issue. The owners, Mr. & Mrs. Joe DeCapio Sr., are both ill and unable to make any decisions on this property. The daughter was going to contact their attorney to see how/what they should do to take care of this issue. Mr. Donahue advised that he would handle the subdivision for them if they wanted to subdivide along with the Loudermilk's. He is still waiting for their response. The Planning Board is satisfied that the Loudermilk's have done all they can to rectify the situation and will move forward with subdividing their two (2) lots to become one (1). The Town Attorney, Jim Gascon, was asked to send a letter to the DeCapio's to see if we could rectify their subdivision issues. Mr. Donahoe will submit corrected subdivision maps at the April meeting. The Board cannot make a decision regarding the special permit until the subdivision is corrected and approved.
